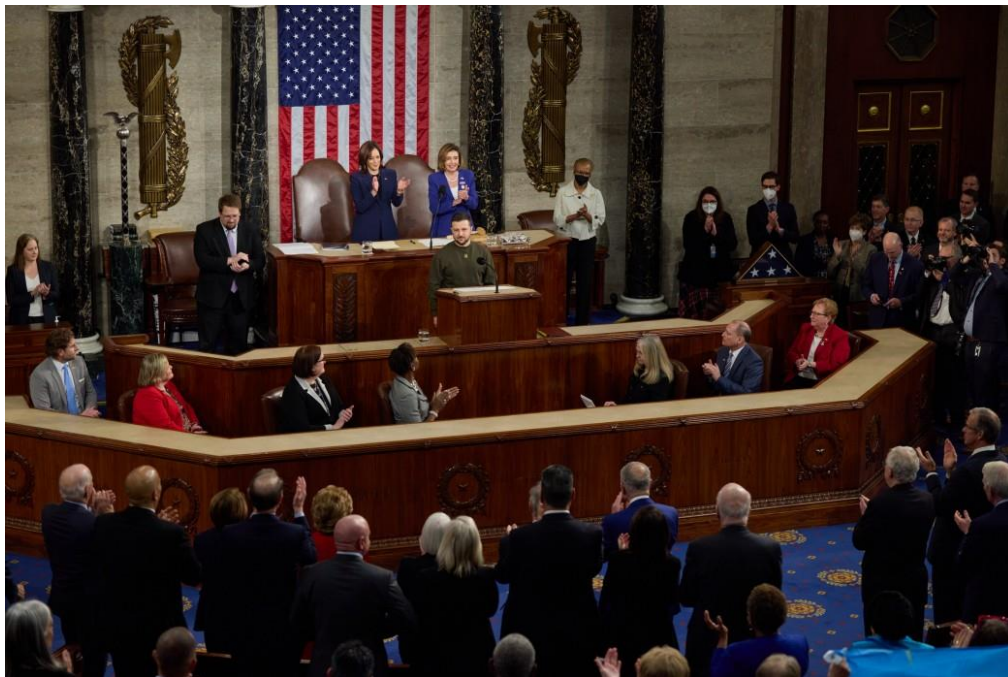

Sunday, December 25, 2022: On the Christmas day, the world wants to know whether President Joe Biden and President Vladimir Putin truly want peace.

It has been reported that President Putin said in Moscow: “Russia is ready to negotiate with all parties, involved in the Ukraine war”. But there were voices from Kremlin, which talked about the objectives of the Ukraine Operation (presumably the annexation of the four regions: Kherson, Zaporizhzhia, Luhansk and Donetsk, in addition to retention of Crimea.)

Reports from Kyiv, after President Zelensky's visit to Washington say that during the visit of President Volodymyr Zelensky to Washington DC, President Joe Biden agreed to supply Patriot Missile system along with a large financial support for the budget of Ukraine. In his address to the US Congress, Zelensky said, "Your money is not charity. It's an **investment in global security and democracy** that we handle in the most responsible way.

This has been interpreted by many commentators as Biden's effort for a more intensive war for bringing Russia to its knees so that Putin may be thrown out by the Russians. President also claimed that he had discussed with President Biden a peace package, which includes a compensation package for the losses suffered by Ukraine.

President Putin called Patriot defense system as an outdated one. **Does it mean that Ukraine war will move towards even more lethal weapons on Ukrainian cities?**

Henry Kissinger mentioned that the world had sleep-walked into WW I, even though no country wanted a war in 1914. He has written recently that the peace agreement at the end of World War I led to World War II, since the allies decided to humiliate Germany further after its defeat at WW I.

DiGiNews360 agrees with Henry Kissinger for the need for an immediate ceasefire. The decisions about the territories may be by mutual agreement. Or it may be forced by the Security Council. Alternatively, it may be by a referendum of the people of the four territories, as suggested by Henry Kissinger.
