

Ukraine War: To become more ferocious?

Disturbing signs of hardliners coming forward, in both Russia and the west to fight with more lethal weapons - in search for a complete victory over the other, are becoming apparent on this last day of the year.

In a Telegram, former Russian President Dmitry Medvedev warned against providing the “Ukrainian fanatics” with Patriots and NATO personnel. He said these would be legitimate targets for Russian forces.

At a meeting of the Russian Forces, Russian President Vladimir Putin described the situation in the four regions in eastern Ukraine: Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhia and Kherson as very serious and asked for more intensive war efforts.



Mike Watson of the Hudson Institute think tank criticized Germany as a ‘procrastinator’ for not spending 2% of its GDP on defense, in an article in the Wall Street Journal. This is a continuation of the policy of President Trump of asking its NATO partners to spend more on arms.
