1. **International Kite Festival, Gujarat:** Shri Bhupendrabhai Patel, the Chief Minister of Gujarat, inaugurated the Festival on 8th January, 2023, at the riverfront, Ahmedabad. He said, "Kite-making is a Rs 625 crore industry today and it employs 1.3 lac people."

Due to Covid restrictions, the festival was not organized for 2 years. This year, 126 Kite-fliers from 68 countries, 65 from 14 States and more than 660 from different districts of Gujarat are taking part in the Kite Festival. 3. **Electric 2-Wheeler and a fully automated Battery Manufacturing Plant:** Jindal Mobiltrac, a subsidiary of the textile company Jindal Worldwide Ltd. will set up the two plants for manufacturing 2.5 lakh 2-wheelers per annum on the outskirts of Ahmedabad. JWJ had acquired the start-up Earth Energy Electric Vehicles in May 2022, to obtain the technology. JWJ is setting up a dealer network in 10 States and in Nepal.
