Sixth G20 meeting in Ahmedabad from February 8-10: Delegations sfrom 35 international cities will participate in this 6th meeting.
The meeting will promote solidarity of cities so that the cities can collaborate to find common solutions to their problems.

The plenary session will be held on 9th February. It will have an address by the Chief Minister, Bhupendrbhai Patel. Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, the Union Minister for housing and urban affairs, will participate in the plenary session virtually from Delhi. A Call for Action for taking forward the Agenda for Sustainable Development by cities will be given by Shri Amitabh Kant, Indian Sherpa for G20.

February 7, 2023: Dharampur, Gujarat: Tribals start taking pride in their culture and dialects: In tribal dominated Talukas of Dharampur and Kaprada, the invitation cards for marriage show that the tribals have started taking pride in their culture and dialects.
