1. February 14, 2023: **Election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of Amul Dairy:** Since the term of Ramsinh Parmar and Rajendrasinh Parmar, the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman of the Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF) is going to be over, the election of the new Chairman and Vice Chairman are scheduled to be held on 14th February. Either Vipulbhai Patel Dumralwala or Rajesh Pathak is likely to be the new Chairman. 2. February 13, 2023: **Boeing India President announces setting up a Logistics Center and its first Global Support Center in India:** Salil Gupte announced investment of Rs 2 billion on setting up of a Logistics Center in India. It will reduce time required for supplying spares for both the commercial and defense users of Boeing aircrafts, thereby reducing down-time for repairs. The Global Support Center at Gurgaon will be able to deliver customized operational efficiency, safety improvement and aircraft-reliability projects for Boeing’s customers.
Meanwhile Air India is planning a mega-order for 220 Boeing planes – 190 single aisle B737 Max, 20 B787 Dreamliners and 10 B777X.

February 11, 2023: Gwalior: **A Special Marriage Reception by a Municipal Commissioner:** Mr. Kishore Kanyale, the Municipal Commissioner of Gwalior, a city in Madhya Pradesh, India organized a marriage reception on the occasion of his daughter’s marriage in a well-known hotel.
