OP ED in The New York Post: In the OP ED, Nikki Haley said, "Backing American allies and friends like Israel and Ukraine is smart. Sending our tax dollars to enemies isn't."

Nikki Haley has previously served as ambassador to the United Nations (January 2017 to December 2018) under the Trump administration and as Governor of South Carolina (2011-17).

Haley was born Nimarata Nikki Randhawa in Bamberg, South Carolina, to immigrant Sikh parents from Punjab, India. Her father, Ajit Singh Randhawa, and her mother, Raj Kaur Randhawa, emigrated to the United States from Amritsar District, Punjab, India. Namrata was known by her middle name, Nikki, a Punjabi name, from her earliest years.
