The statute was donated by the Indian community of British Columbia to the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of Simon Fraser University's Burnaby campus. It has been installed at the Peace Square in the Institute for the Humanities.

Thakore Visiting Scholar Award: SFU also confers annually an Award called the Thakore Visiting Scholar Award since 1991. "It honours individuals who have devoted their lives to "creativity, commitment and a deep concern for truth in public life, which includes but is not limited to, showing the connection between academic values and critical public spirit."

"Each year, a remarkable individual, whose life and work embodies Mahatma Gandhi's principles of social justice, non-violence, environmental conservation, conflict resolution and world peace, is honoured at SFU with this award. The recipient also gives the Gandhi Commemorative Lecture at the Institute for the Humanities."

2. February 13, 2023: Mississauga: Khalistanis vandalized the Ram Mandir in Mississauga with anti-India wall paintings. The Ontario and Canadian Governments have not been able to arrest any of the miscreants.

During the last few days, attacks on temples and on Indian consulates in **London, Australia, New York, Los Angeles and Canada** by a handful of Khalistanis at each place have been reported. The objective seems to be to drive a wedge between Hindus and Sikhs. In Delhi, this has led to a counter-reaction from Sikhs, who went in large numbers to the UK High Commission in New Delhi to protest against the UK Government's inaction in the face of the Khalistani attack on the Indian High Commission at London.
