## Nigerian Elections, 2023:

## **Gubernatorial Elections & Our Calls to the Nigerian Society**

April 16, 2023: **After** the Presidential elections of February 25-26, 2023 and the recent Gubernatorial Elections, while some of the supplementary elections are going on and the results are being compiled, as of today, the results of Gubernatorial elections are as follows:

## **Tentative RESULTS:**

On the whole, the number of votes polled during the Gubernatorial elections was less. One reason is that there were no Gubernatorial elections in 8 States.

The biggest loser in terms of votes polled is the Labour party, which had a steep fall between the votes polled during the Presidential and during the Gubernatorial elections. It may be due to the fact that elections to Governors in many strongholds of LP were not scheduled to be held in 2023.

The Election results of the Presidential Elections had showed that besides APC and PDP, a 3<sup>rd</sup> national party (LP) had arisen. The Labour Party wanted ostensibly votes not on the basis of ethnicity but on the basis of competence.

<u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> feels that the steep fall in votes within a short period may also be due to a change in the public perception of Peter Obi. It happened due to the action of some hotheads, among his followers.

In Lagos, some miscreants hoisted the Biafra flag, immediately after Peter Obi got more votes than Bola Tinubu in the State of Lagos. (The President-Elect, as the Governor of Lagos, had done creditable work.) In public perception, admittedly without any proof, the Biafaran flag was put up by Obi's followers.

In a Channels Television's "Politics Today" program, telecast on Wednesday, 22 March, 2023, **Yusuf Datti Baba-Ahmed** called on President Muhammadu Buhari and the Chief Justice of Nigeria not to swear in Bola Tinubu on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Baba-Ahmed was the Labour Party (LP) vice presidential candidate in the elections of 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023. This program was **anchored by Seun Okinbaloye**. The National Broadcasting Commission (<a href="https://www.facebook.com/nbcgovng/">https://www.facebook.com/nbcgovng/</a>) fined Channels Television N5 million for violating the NBC code in the program.

Lastly Peter Obi filed a legal challenge asking that either he should be declared as the winner of the Presidential election of Feb 25-26, 2023 or the election should be annulled.

This made Obi's bright picture, painted during the Presidential election, as a liberal not affected by ethnicity, dimmer.

overwhelmingly. However, if the voting pattern looks to be similar to that in China, it raises **legitimate doubts** about working of the democratic system in these States. Hence, <u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> calls on INEC, the Federal Government, APC, PDP and all organs of society to look into the situation in these States so that **multi-party democracy**, where voting is NOT based on ethnic considerations alone, **can be effectively established in these States also**.

<u>Early Resolution of Court Cases</u>: More than 300 petitions have been filed in various courts against Bola Tinubu, President-Elect by

- the former Vice-President Atiku Abubakar and the Presidential candidate for 2023 of PDP;
