1. May 31, 2023: **Results of Class 12 General Stream by GSHSEB**: The results of 565,000 Class 12 General Stream students, whose examinations were conducted from March 14-28 were declared on Tuesday by Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board.



The results will be available at www.gseb.org at 8 AM on Thursday, June 1, 2023. Students will also be able to get their results through WhatsApp by sending their seat number to the number 63573 00971.

2. May 29, 2023: IPL Final: Torrential Rains during the last 24 hours on Sunday. Manorama Mohanty, Head of India Meteorological Department (IMD), Gujarat said that similar rains during the next 48 hours. The unseasonal rains, between March 1, 2023 to May 28 are due to seven cyclonic circulation system in Saurashtra and NW Rajasthan. A trough in Northern Madhya Pradesh and a Western Disturbance near the borders of Pakistan have also contributed to the rains.

On Sunday, by 10 PM, Ahmedabad got 72.6 mm of rain.

In Ahmedabad, waterlogging was reported from more than 200 spots, 12 roads are damaged, street poles and trees have fallen due to thunderstorm and hailstorm during the last 24 hours. The heavy rains claimed nine lives in Gujarat.



IPL FINALS 2023: The Final was scheduled to take place in Narendra Modi stadium, Ahmedabad on May 29, 2023 between Chennai Super Kings (CSK) and Gujarat Titans (GT). MS Dhoni, Captain of CSK, won the toss and asked GT to bat first.

Wriddhiman Saha and Shubman Gill opened the innings. Saha scored 54 off 39, while Gill was limited to 39 off 20. The slight drizzle through out the GT batting did not cause any stoppage and GT finished with a score of 214/4. As the last batsman of GT, 23-year old Sai Sudharsan contributed 96 off just 47 balls.

However, after the 3rd ball of the 1st over of CSK, heavy rains stopped the play. Though it was a short spell, wetness of the outfield and loss of time, reduced the match to 15 overs and CSK's target was revised to 171.

Devon Conway, Ajinkya Rahane, Shivam Dube and Ambati Rayudu helped add to CSK's kitty of runs. Mohit Sharma bowled well and took some important wickets. When Mohit Sharma got rid of Ambati Rayudu and MS Dhoni off successive deliveries, Gujarat seemed in charge. At the fag-end with 10 needed off 2 balls, Sharma, unfortunately, bowled a couple of average deliveries. Ravindra Jadeja of CSK played a sixer from the second last ball and then took four out of the last ball to lead CSK to a five wicket-win.

On MS Dhoni, Hardik Pangya, the Captain of GT, said that he was very happy for Dhoni. He added that destiny was on Dhoni's side and he doesn't mind losing to Dhoni.

AWARDS for the MATCH: **Devon Conway:** the PLAYER OF THE MATCH for his quick-fire knock of 47 runs off 25 balls.

Mohammad Shami wins the award for the **leading wicket-taker of the season**. Shami picked up 28 wickets in 17 innings and at an average of 18.61.

AWARDS FOR THE TOURNAMENT: **Shubman Gill** was adjudged the MOST VALUABLE PLAYER OF THE TOURNAMENT for his sensational season. Gill also won the **leading run-scorer of the tournament** as he scored 890 runs in 17 innings that included 3 centuries as well and he did all that at an average of 59.33 and a strikerate of 157.80.

Yashasvi Jaiswal was awarded the EMERGING PLAYER OF THE TOURNAMENT for scoring 625 runs in 14 innings at an average of 48.08 and a strike rate of 163.61.

3. May 29, 2023: Vil. Chorwad, Dist. Junagadh, Gujarat, India: **Dhirubhai Ambani Memorial House:** 27-storey Antilia in Mumbai is known to be the costliest home in India and it is the residence of Mukesh Ambani, the richest man of India.



His father late Dhirubhai Ambani was born in a rented home in village Chorwad. He came from a family, which had no assets or funds. Starting with a job as a daily wager in a gas station, Dhirubhai created an industrial empire before his death.



Ambani family has purchased the old home and 1.2 acres of land around the home, where Dhirubhai was born in 1932. A visitor today

can see the home, as it was about 90 years back. The same old 2-storey architecture, old furniture, kitchen etc have been retained. A garden of coconut trees and a small theater, where one can see a film on Dhirubhai's life, have been built at the back of the home.

4. May 29, 2023: **Fee Hike in Technical Colleges**: Gujarat has 589 Colleges imparting education in engineering, pharmacy, architecture, MBA, MCA, Hotel Management and Diploma courses.

496 of these Colleges have applied to Gujarat Government for permitting a Fee-hike of 15% to 35%. The Government has appointed a Fee Regulatory Committee, headed by Justice Akshay Mehta, a former Judge of Gujarat High Court, to study and decide on these demands.

The Committee will visit the Colleges and then decide on the quantum of Fee Hike, after assessing the facilities and the expenses, required to run the College well.

Due to low demand, many Colleges have not increased the fees for the last 7 years. With continuous inflation, this has created a situation, where the Colleges do not have funds for improving or expanding the infrastructure. **Professor Kamlesh Joshipura**, Member of the Fee Regulatory Committee, said that the committee will decide on the hike in a judicious manner.
