The Peace Park at Hiroshima has been set up at exactly the place, where for the first time, an atom bomb was dropped on 6th August 1945.

On 15-16 November, 2014, the ninth G20 summit was hosted by Australia in the city of Brisbane, the capital city of Queensland, Australia. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, during his visit to participate in the G20 summit, dedicated a statue of Mahatma Gandhi to Australia.

The 7th **BRICS Summit** was held in Ufa, Russia on July 8-9, 2015.

The annual summit of the **Shanghai Cooperation Organization** also took place in Ufa, Russia on July 9-10, 2015. At this meeting was ratified the expansion of membership to include India and Pakistan as Members of SCO.

On 10-11, July 2015, Prime Minister was on a visit to Turkmenistan, where he unveiled a bust of Mahatma Gandhi in Ashgabat, the capital of Turkmenistan.

On July 11-12, 2015, at the invitation of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic Almazbek Atambaev, Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi, paid an Official Visit to the Kyrgyzstan. Prime Minister Narendra Modi appreciated the decision of the

Kyrgyz side to install a statue of Mahatma Gandhi in Bishkek city, which was ceremoniously unveiled by the Prime Minister during his visit.
