Nigeria: Program of Inaugural Activities & Court Cases

May 19, 2023

On February 25-26, 2023, Presidential elections took place in Nigeria. INEC declared the results on March 1, 2023 by issuing a Certificate to Bola Tinubu as the President-Elect. Within a few days, Tinubu was provided with a residence in Defence House to begin the process of transfer of power from President Muhammadu Buharu on May 29, 2023.

INAUGURAL PROGRAM Press Conference: May 18, 2023: Boss Mustapha, Secretary to the Government of the Federation (SGF) and Chairman, Presidential Transition Council, held a press conference at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and announced the program of Inauguration. He said the theme of the 2023 Transition has been chosen as follows:

'NIGERIA: Better Together'

On 29th May 2023 will be the 7th consecutive democratic transition of power at the Federal level in Nigeria.

In February, 2023, the President through Executive Order 14, approved the establishment of the Presidential Transition Council (PTC). The 24-member Council inclusive of two representatives of the President-Elect was inaugurated on 14th February 2023.

The PTC also built on the foundation laid by the Transition Technical Task Team (TTTT) which I inaugurated in December 2022. The Task Team is the product of a collaborative effort between the Federal Government and development partners including

- Nigerian Think Tank: Nigerian Economic Summit Group (NESG)
- Nigeria Governors' Forum (NGF)

Thus the Inauguration festival will begin on Tuesday, 23rd May 2023.

COURT CASES: After INEC declared the result of the Presidential elections, PDP and Labor parties had filed the court petitions against Bola Tinubu's election in the Court of Appeal.



The Presidential Election Petition Court began its sitting in Abuja last Monday. Five members of the court panel are:

- 1. Haruna Tsammani, presiding justice of Abuja Division (63)
- 2. Stephen Adah, presiding justice, Asaba Division (65)
- 3. Misitura Bolaji-Yusuf, Asaba Division (63)
- 4. Moses Ugo, Kano Division (57)
- **5.** Abba Mohammed, Ibadan Division (62)

The Judges are drawn from five of the six geo-political regions of Nigeria – Southwest, South-south, North-west, North-East and North-central.

They have up to September to deliver their judgement, and a displeased party can still appeal to the Supreme Court.

The sprawling complex of the Court of Appeal headquarters is perched on the fringes of the Three Arms Zone, Abuja – the domicile of Nigeria's highest executive, legislative and judicial powers.
