
Indo-US Relations: Modi's State Visit_ Part 2

June 22-23, Washington D.C.: **President Joe Biden** met India's **Prime Minister Narendra Modi,** on an **official state visit** to USA.



During an event with the Hudson Institute, **Kurt Campbell**, the National Security Council coordinator for the Indo-Pacific said that **this visit** basically **consecrates the U.S. and India relationship as the most important bilateral relationship for the United States** on the global stage.

<u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> looks at the treatment of PM Narendra Modi with great honor by President Joe Biden and statements like those by Kurt Campbell above. We also look at the "Efforts to Dislodge Modi in 2024", based in USA. (Please see Appendix 1 below.)

<u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u>, therefore, believes that the Biden group in the Democratic Party wants to work with Narendra Modi for carrying forward the ideas of Democracy to stem the progress of President Xi Jinping's philosophy. But there is another group in Democratic Party, led by Barrack Obama and supported by Soros' billions, which wants to get rid of Modi.

Secondly Antony Blinken, the US Secretary of State, visited China and had two

days of meetings with senior officers and President Xi Jinping. It seems that the two sides discussed the issue of Taiwan Strait and have temporarily stabilized the region against the break-out of a war. However, Blinken and Xi did not discuss the issue of instability at the Indo-China border. Can it be interpreted as a signal from USA to China that USA would remain neutral, if China were to attack India?



India has been trying to strengthen its own defense and is trying to be selfreliant in production of arms. India has also not sought any Treaty for its Security.

However, the QUAD is mentioned in the Statement on Modi-Biden discussions and President Biden said that QUAD would stabilize the Indo-Pacific region at the Joint Press Conference.

Question by <u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u>: Does it mean that India has agreed to participate in stabilizing the Indo-Pacific, without any corresponding benefit to itself? Or India may have decided that this is the price to be paid for acquiring advanced technologies with help from US Government.

Open societies have to not only cope up with the issues of good governance, of building plural societies which value merit and excellence in every endeavour,

while taking care of those, who may be left behind due to any reasons, they also have to deal with disruptions, engineered by dictatorial regimes of the world.

In India, it is said that a few TV and print media are supported by China. These channels are working to scuttle the Indo-US Agreements and to mould the public opinion against the interests of India and of democracies of the world. Similarly, China is exploiting the open society of USA to support media, think tanks, NGOs and Think Tanks, which weaken USA wrt China and also attempt to mould public opinion against closer relations among democracies so that they are not able to work in co-ordination to strengthen the democracies of the world.

During Modi's visit of June 21-23, 2023 to USA, Indians have noticed the coordinated protests by Khalistanis, IAMC and ISI. Mr. Rajiv Malhotra has documented the work done by some Research Groups at Harvard University and Equality Lab of Seattle in coordination with each other to attack India and even Indian Americans.

Only if India and USA work jointly with other democracies with strong resolve will it be possible to sustain and enhance the spread of democracies in the world so that human beings can live with dignity everywhere in the world.



SUMMARY: Modi's State Visit has succeeded in bringing USA and India closer. India's friendship and strategic relationship with USA is crucial for President Biden's policy of forming an Axis of Democracies.

Major gains to India are US Government's agreement to permit India to have crucial technologies, important for India, if it is to reduce its dependence on China and become self-reliant.

If both Indian industries as well as executive officers in States and central levels in India prove to be as intelligent as those in China were from 1985 to 2008, the **policy agreements between Biden and Modi** can **strengthen India's hard power** capabilities and increase **India's manufacturing base**. However, if India is slow in taking advantage of the Biden-Modi Agreements, the stance of US government may change and hard advantages from the Visit, for which Modi Government had worked hard, may vanish.

<u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> and India will have to evaluate whether India has been able to move up the technological and manufacturing capabilities so that India and the world are able to become independent of China for crucial supplies. If India fails to realize the potential, unleashed by the Modi-Biden Agreement, it will be a loss for not only India, it may become difficult for open societies of the world to withstand commercial and technological blackmailing by China, which is today the sole source of many of the products, used by the people and industries of the world.

EFFORTS TO DISLODGE MODI IN 2024: In democratic India, the opposition parties will naturally try to defeat **Bharatiya Janata Party** (Modi's party) during the elections of 2024.
