USA: Trump: State of Presidential Campaign on January 21, 2024

January 14, 2024: Manchester, New Hampshire, USA.: Governor Ron DeSantis of Florida suspended his campaign for President on Sunday and endorsed former President Donald J. Trump, as Vivek Ramaswamy had done on January 15, 2024 after the Iowa caucuses.

Gov DeSantis had a 30-percentage-point loss to Mr. Trump in the Iowa caucuses last Monday, January 15, 2024. On Sunday, January 21, 2024, the Governor said," There was no point in soldiering on without a clear path to victory." From South Carolina, Mr. DeSantis had gone back to **Tallahassee** canceling his appointments in New Hampshire.

Till a few weeks back, Governor Ron DeSantis was said to have the best chance to dethrone Mr. Trump as the Republican Party's nominee in 2024.
