UN Humanitarian Aid to Gaza, Killing of Innocent Civilians March 3, 2024

March 3, 2024: **Washington D.C.** and **Gaza**: United States military carried out its 1st airdrop of humanitarian aid into Gaza on Saturday, with the support of Israel, after UNRWA warned of a growing humanitarian disaster in the Palestinian enclave as Israel pressed on with its offensive. Three C-130 planes delivered more than 35,000 meals into a territory where the United Nations says one quarter of the population is one step from famine.

With doubts surrounding the resumption of ceasefire talks in Egypt on Sunday, 25th February 2024, this seemed to be the only immediate step that President Joe Biden could take.

March 3, 2024: Gaza: The Hamas health ministry in the Gaza Strip said at least 11 Palestinians, including one medic, were killed when an Israeli airstrike hit a tent in Rafah, where people are seeking sanctuary from Israel's military offensive. It said another 50 people were wounded in the strike next to a hospital in the **Tel Al-Sultan area of Rafah**. The Israeli military did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

More than a million Palestinians have sought refuge in the Rafah area of Gaza, fleeing the Israeli offensive, launched in response to the October 7 attack by the Hamas terrorists in the border areas of Israel with Gaza.

On October 7, 2024, Hamas killed 1,200 civilians, including 45 children in a School and severely handicapped old persons. Hamas also abducted 253 hostages.

U.S. President Joe Biden has said he hopes a ceasefire will be in place by the time of the Muslim fasting month of Ramadan, which starts on March 10. Speaking to reporters on Friday, he said: "We're not there yet."

March 1-3, 2024: Gaza: Thirteen children have died at the Kamal Adwan hospital in northern Gaza in the last three days from dehydration and malnutrition, according to the Hamas' Gaza Ministry of Health. Doctor Imad Dardonah said malnutrition caused a number of the diseases among the children.

February 29, 2024, **Gaza**: Mutual distrust led to an unfortunate incident in Gaza, where civilians had gathered in a large number for getting food, which was being distributed by an aid agency.

In the same area Hamas was active and a unit of **Israel Defense Force** (IDF) went in pursuit. A large g3roup of the Palestinians started moving towards the unit of IDF. The unit, to protect itself, opened fire. Hamas' Health authorities in Gaza said 115 people were killed in Thursday's incident, calling it a massacre.

Israel disputed those figures and said most victims were trampled or run over.

Period till March 3, 2024 from October 7, 2023: **West Bank**: During the war, Israel has also stepped up raids in the West Bank, where U.N. records show that at least 358 people have been killed since October 7.

The official Palestinian news agency WAFA reported on Saturday, March 2, 2024, that Israeli forces shot a 16-year-old in the head near the hub city of Ramallah, killing him. The Israeli military said its forces were conducting "routine activity" in the town of **Kafr Ni'ma near Ramallah** when dozens of people began hurling rocks and explosives at its forces, who responded with live fire, hitting one person.

January 17, 2024: Doha, Qatar: Wael Dahdouh, Al Jazeera's Gaza Bureau Chief, was able to reach Doha, for medical treatment, on **Tuesday night**, via Egypt. He was wounded in an Israeli drone strike in December in which Al Jazeera Arabic's cameraperson **Samer Abudaqa** was killed while they were reporting in Southern Gaza.

Dahdouh, who left the besieged enclave, for the first time, since 7th October 2023, lost his wife Amna, son Mahmoud, daughter Sham and grandson Adam in October after an Israeli air raid hit the home they were sheltering in at the **Nuseirat Refugee Camp**, after being displaced from their house in Gaza City. Earlier this month, the 53-year-old veteran journalist's eldest son, Hamza, also an Al Jazeera journalist, was killed by an Israeli missile strike in **Khan Younis**, Southern Gaza.
