Khalistanis: The World starts Action against the terrorists

March 12, 2024: London, UK: UK Government's Task Force for facing pro-Khalistan extremism, launched last year, following a meeting between External Affairs Minister **Dr. S Jaishankar** and UK Security Minister **Tom Tugendhat**, has frozen over 300 bank accounts and seized approximately £10 Mn. The global reach of Khalistanis was revealed by discovery of suspicious transactions across Canada, the United States, Australia, and New Zealand.

£2 Mn was found in the account of **Sikhs for Justice** (SFJ), a pro-Khalistan organization, named as **a terrorist organization** by the Government of India. UK's task force is keeping a watch on over 5,000 accounts.

UNITED STATES of AMERICA: Khalistani-related Anti-India Activism: has increased within the US, as the US and India collaborate to confront the rise of China, especially in the Indo-Pacific. <u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> thinks that the supporters of China and Pakistan (*a critical Chinese ally*) are jointly working **to sabotage President Joe Biden's policy of seeking Indian collaboration** with Japan, Australia and South Korea to face the aggressive stance of China in the Indo-Pacific seas.

AUSTRALIA: Indian **National Investigation Agency** (NIA) found that Khalistani gangs send money generated through extortion to Australia, for supporting pro-Khalistan elements.

CANADA: The **Canada-India Counter-Terrorism Working Group** was supposed to facilitate and co-ordinate the efforts of the two governments so that Khalistani terrorist activities could be eliminated. However, to ward off the allegations of **Pierre Poilievre**, Leader of the Official Opposition of Canada, about PM **Justin Trudeau**'s weakness in facing up to China's interference in Canadian affairs, PM **Trudeau** has started supporting **Jagmeet Singh**'s allegations of suspicions of interference by agencies of Government of India in the internal affairs of Canada. The Indian Government considers **Jagmeet Singh** to be a Khalistani.

The separatist Khalistan movement was initiated by the Pakistan's Army, after the shameful surrender of more than 90,000 soldiers and Officers of the Pakistan's Army before the Indian Army in 1971. For this purpose, Pakistan's secret service took the help of certain anti-Indian elements in British Columbia, Canada. These groups had been cultivated by **Colonel Hutchinson** of the British Secret Service for suppressing the **Gadar Movement** (*which sought to send arms to India for fighting for India's Independence from UK, during 1920s-30s.*)

However, recent surveys reveal that the overwhelming majority of Sikhs, both in India and abroad, strongly identify with their Indian heritage.
