

## Modi: Bringing US and Russian Navies together, “Use him for PEACE?”

March 9, 2024

March 9, 2024: **Delhi, India:** India succeeded in bringing the **USS Halsey from the USA**, the **IRIS Dena from Iran**, and the **Varyag from Russia**, alongside other international fleets, to jointly work for a common goal.

Jerusalem Post has reported that the 12th edition of Biennial Multinational Naval exercise MILAN was hosted in Visakhapatnam, India. (Reference: <https://tinyurl.com/3dvn63tz>) It was a nine-day naval exercise with participation of over 50 Navies, when the security of commercial shipping was causing increasing concerns, all over the world. Among the 50 Navies were included navies from the US, Russia, Iran, Japan, Australia, France, Bangladesh, South Korea, Vietnam, Indonesia and Malaysia.



**In 1991**, India’s Prime Minister **P.V. Narsimha Rao** initiated the “look East” policy to strengthen India’s relationship with East Asian countries. One strand of implementation of the Policy was MILAN, which was started in 1995 with Navies of India, Indonesia, Singapore, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

In India, MILAN was the responsibility of Indian Navy’s ‘Andaman and Nicobar Command’ till its 10th edition. As the participation increased, Visakhapatnam was chosen as the venue for the exercise, so that a larger staging and hosting base is available.

Visakhapatnam is a commercial hub, large port, steep coastal gradient closer to its shores enabling ships to operate closer to the shore and long coastline offering excellent viewing experience, particularly from the RamaKrishna beach, for the public.

MILAN comprises two phases:

**Harbour Phase:** to promote cultural sharing amongst the participating nations, would consist of an international maritime seminar, international city parade, maritime exhibition and various sporting events.

**Sea Phase:** large-force manoeuvres, advanced air defence operations, anti-submarine warfare and anti-surface operations by ships along with aircraft of friendly foreign countries along with the Indian Navy's aircraft and other units

UNPRECEDENTED DIPLOMATIC SUCCESS: The countries, which are actively engaged in **clash of arms** through their allies or 'client-militias', were able to come together in the interest of the **common goals of safe commercial shipping** and in the interest of **reducing inflation**.

*Why should Ukraine and Gaza WARS continue, when NO ONE want to?*

USA: The grants for continuing the wars in Ukraine and Gaza have not been approved for nearly a month by the US Congress.

**Trump**, the (*likely*) Republican Nominee for the Presidential elections of November 2024 does not want to continue the war in Ukraine.

**Biden**, the (*likely*) Democratic Nominee for the Presidential elections of November 2024 wants an immediate ceasefire in Gaza, if he is not to lose the support of an important and vocal part of his party in Michigan and other cities.

EUROPE: UK and the EU are not able to provide adequate support to Kyiv, jointly or separately, so that President **Volodymyr Oleksandrovykh Zelenskyy** can face Russia.

Ukrainian army chiefs have asked President **Zelenskyy** to mobilise up to 500,000 **additional soldiers** as the country gears up for a protracted war of attrition against Russia next year.

In a rare public intervention on the matter, **General Kyrylo Budanov**, head of Ukraine's Military Intelligence, said on Sunday, March 10, 2024, that Ukraine had already recruited all the volunteers it could find and now needed to use more compulsion.

General **Valeriy Zaluzhny**, Commander-in-Chief of Ukraine's Armed Forces, is said to have resigned since President **Zelenskyy** wanted him not to speak in public about the need for additional soldiers.

NATO's new estimate is that Russia has cranked up its defense production to levels, much higher than the estimates, made even 3 months earlier. The sanctions by the west have not succeeded in crippling the Russian economy. However, President **Vladimir Putin**, in his first one-on-one interview with former Fox News host **Tucker Carlson**, after February 24, 2022, has urged Washington to recognize Moscow's interests, and press Kyiv to sit down for talks.

**Dmitry Medvedev**, Deputy Chairman of the Security Council of the Russian Federation, has recently stated Russian conditions for ending the war in such a way that Ukraine does not pose a threat to Russia by joining NATO. This statement can be construed as the first step for starting negotiations for peace by Russia.

EUROPE: UNPREPARED for WAR and FEAR of WAR: UK's Defense Minister has stated that UK was not ready for a war with Russia. The European media has widely published the fears of Poland, Finland, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, when the Russian President talked about the historical kingdom of Tsars from 1721 to 1917. Sweden's Civil Defense Minister, **Carl-Oskar Bohlin**, speaking at the Folk Och Forsvar conference (roughly translated as the "Society and Defense" conference) in Salen, expressed fears about the possibility of a war after more than a century of avoiding war through neutrality. Russia called the German ambassador, when Germany signed an agreement to support Kyiv with arms, when both Germany and Russia know about the low expense on armed forces by Germany for two decades.
