India Votes: 5th Phase May 20, 2024

May 17, 2024: **Delhi**, India: In the **fifth phase**, 49 constituencies across 6 States and 2 Union Territories will participate in electing **Members of Parliament** (MPs) to the **Lok Sabha** (*the lower house of Parliament*). The two main contenders for power are Prime Minister **Narendra Modi**'s governing **Bharatiya Janata Party** (BJP) and the **Indian National Developmental Inclusive** (I.N.D.I.) Alliance, a coalition of 26 parties led by the main opposition party, **Indian National Congress** (INC), the Grand Old Party, which had ruled over India for 54 years, after independence on August 15, 1947.

The decision makers in INC are a family of three persons, led by **Sonia Gandhi**, a naturalized Indian of Italian origin. Her son **Rahul Gandhi** and daughter **Priyanka Gandhi-Vadra** are the other two. Nominally Shri **Mallikarjun Kharge** is President of INC since October 19, 2022.

The cumulative turnout in the first four phases of the Lok Sabha elections has been recorded at 66.95%, the Election Commission said on Thursday, adding 451 Mn of

the nearly 969 Mn electors have voted so far in the ongoing electoral exercise. The updated voter turnout in the first four phases was **69.16%**, **68.4%**, **66.71%** and **66.14%**, respectively, which is lower than that in the 2019 elections. Overall, there are **543 parliamentary constituencies** across **36 States** and Federally-governed **Union Territories**.

KEY CANDIDATES in LOK SABHA ELECTIONS PHASE 5:

- 1.Rae Bareli, UP: **Rahul Gandhi**, representing INC, contests from Rae Bareli, the **family stronghold**. He won from Kerala's Wayanad in 2019. BJP has fielded **Dinesh Pratap Singh** against him.
- 2. Amethi, UP: BJP's **Smriti Irani**, who defeated Rahul Gandhi in 2019, competes against Congress' **Kishori Lal Sharma** in Amethi.

- 3. Lucknow, UP: **Rajnath Singh**, BJP, faces **Ravidas Mehrotra** from Samajwadi Party in Lucknow. He won with huge margins in 2014 and 2019. **Rajnath Singh** is the Defense Minister of India.
- 3. Kaiserganj, UP: Son of **Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh**, **Karan Bhushan Singh**, contests from Kaiserganj. He's a UP Wrestling Association President.

- 4. Saran, Bihar: RJD's **Rohini Acharya**, Lalu Prasad's daughter, who donated one of her kidneys to her father, competes against BJP's **Rajiv Pratap Rudy** in Saran. Rudy won in 2014 and 2019. **Rajiv Pratap Rudy** had defeated **Rabri Devi, Rohini Acharya'** mother in 2019.
- 5. Hajipur, Bihar: LJP's **Chirag Paswan** competes against RJD's **Chandra Ram** in Hajipur. In 2019, **Pashupati Kumar Paras** won the seat.
- 6. Mumbai North: BJP's **Piyush Goyal** contests from Mumbai North against Congress' **Bhushan Patil**. **Piyush Goyal** is the **Minister of Commerce and Industry** in the Union Cabinet.
- 5. Mumbai South, Maharashtra: Shiv Sena UBT Party's Arvind Sawant, a two-time MP, competes against CM Shinde's ally Yamini Jadhav of Shiv Sena.
- 6. Mumbai North-Central: BJP's **Ujjwal Nikam** faces INC's **Varsha Gaikwad**.
- 7. Baramulla, J&K: **National Conference**'s (NC's) **Omar Abdullah** competes against PDP's **Fayaz Ahmad Mir** and PC's **Sajjad Gani Lone**. He is a former Chief Minister of J&K State. He belongs to the Shaikh Abdullah family.

NC president and former J&K Chief Minister **Farooq Abdullah**, his son **Omar Abdullah** and his two grandsons and first-time electors **Zahir** and **Zamir** cast their vote at the polling station at the Burn Hall School here.

For the Srinagar seat, the NC has fielded influential Shia leader and former minister **Aga Ruhullah Mehdi,** with the support of **I.N.D.I. Alliance.** It is after decades that a member of the Abdullah family is not a candidate from the Srinagar constituency.
