India: Andhra Pradesh: Chandrababu Naidu is the new Chief Minister
June 14, 2024

June 13, 2024: **Tirumala Temple**, AP, India: A day after taking over as the Chief Minister of **Andhra Pradesh** (AP), **Chandrababu Naidu** visited the **Venkateswara Swamy Temple in Tirumala** on Thursday. He offered prayers at the temple and vowed to "cleanse" the administration of the **Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams** (TTD). During the Jagan Mohan Reddy Government, there were allegations that the resources of TTD were being mis-directed to help Christian missionaries, since **Jagan Reddy** and his father - **Yeduguri Sandinti Rajasekhara Reddy** - were known to be Christians. The TDP chief said he was committed to eliminating corruption and protecting 'Hindu Dharma' in Tirumala.

"Cleansing in the state will start from Tirumala," he said. "In Tirumala, nothing but the chanting of Govinda's name will be heard. It is not right to desecrate the sacred Tirumala. When you come to Tirumala, you get the feeling of Vaikuntha. There should be no other slogan on Tirumala except **Om Namo Venkatesaya**."

June 12, 2024: Vijayawada, State of Andhra Pradesh: N Chandrababu Naidu was sworn in as the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh (AP) for a fourth term on Wednesday. Syed Abdul Nazeer, Governor of AP (former Justice of the Supreme Court of India) administered the oath of office to Naidu and to ministers of the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government, which replaced the Yuvajana Sramika Rythu Congress Party ("Youth, Labour and Farmer Congress Party") Government on June 12, 2024. or YSR Congress Party (YSRCP)

Prime Minister Narendra Modi was present at the stage. Union ministers Amit Shah and Nitin Gadkari, JP Nadda, the President of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Union minister Bandi Sanjay from Telangana and other leaders from NDA were also present. Tamil superstar Thalaivar ("Leader") Rajnikanth and Telugu Film Superstars Chiranjeevi, Ram Charan, Allu Arjun, Jr NTR and Mohan Babu were present at the occasion.

In a post on X, **Chandrababu Naidu** said, "The oath-taking ceremony shone even brighter today with the presence of our cinema legends. I thank Thalaivar @rajinikanthGaru, @KChiruTweets Garu, @AlwaysRamCharan Garu, and every superstar who graced the occasion."

In 2024, In Andhra Pradesh, NDA, comprising **Telugu Desam Party**, **Jan Sena Party** and **BJP**, was able to defeat YSRCP Government, led by Jagan Mohan Reddy. <u>YSRCP</u> ruled AP from 2019-24.

NDA was founded <u>in May 1998</u> to contest elections in India against a coalition, led by **Indian National Congress** (INC) by the former Prime Minister of India **Atal Bihari Vajpayee** and the former Deputy Prime Minister **L. K. Advani**.

In a post on X, PM **Modi** said: Congratulations to Shri **@ncbn Garu** on becoming the Chief Minister and also to all the others who took oath as Ministers in the Government. The **NDA Government**, comprising **@JaiTDP**, **@JanaSenaParty** and **@BJP4Andhra**, is fully committed to taking AP to new heights of glory and fulfilling the aspirations of the state's youth.

June 12, 2024: **Amravati**, Andhra Pradesh: The victory of NDA and **Telugu Desam Party** (TDP) owed a great deal to the strenuous statewide **Yuva Galam** ("Voice of the Youth") **padayatra** ("Campaign on foot") of over 3,000 Km by **Nara Lokesh**.

In the General Elections of 2019, **Lokesh** lost the election to YSRCP's *A Ramakrishna Reddy* in **Mangalagiri Assembly** constituency. After the elections were over, **Nara Lokesh** used the **padayatra**, to visit every part of AP, to obtain first-hand knowledge of every area in the State.

The **padayatra** lasted for 226 day from 27th January to 18th December 2023.

---- A BACKGROUNDER on YSR Congress Party of Andhra Pradesh ----

Yuvajana Sramika Rythu Congress Party ("Youth, Labour and Farmer Congress Party") or YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) was founded on March 12, 2011 by Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy, son of the former Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh (AP) - Y. S. Rajasekhara Reddy (YSR) - in a helicopter crash in September 2009.

Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy started on an Odarpu Yatra ("condolence tour") across Andhra Pradesh, to console the families of those who had committed suicide or died of shock after the death of his father.


EDITORIAL COMMENT: <u>www.DiGiNews360.com</u> knows that Y. S. **Rajasekhara Reddy** was a very popular leader. However, it is difficult to believe that any of his followers would have committed a suicide, after the accidental death of **Rajasekhara Reddy.**

Odarpu Yatra was not supported by the Congress leadership. Defying the **Congress Working Committee**'s order to call off the tour, **Jagan** went ahead with the first leg of the **Yatra** in the **West Godavari** and **Khammam districts** in April 2010.

Meanwhile, Sakshi TV news channel and Sakshi newspaper, which are closely affiliated with YSR and Jagan, had been continuously criticizing the new Chief Minister Konijeti Rosaiah and the Congress leadership at New Delhi.

After accusing the Congress of ill-treating him and of 'creating a rift in his family by luring his uncle, Y. S. Vivekananda Reddy, the younger brother of YSR, with a state ministerial slot in the aftermath of the death of his father', Jagan and his mother, Y. S. Vijayamma, resigned from the Kadapa Lok Sabha and Pulivendula Assembly constituencies respectively and also as members of the Congress in November 2010.

In the bye-elections, YSR Congress Party (YSRCP), established on March 12, 2011, YSRCP succeeded in winning most of the seats. But, when in 2014, a General Election was held for all the seats in the Legislative Assembly, along with the elections to the Union Parliament, tp won a majority. In 2019, YSRCP was able to turn the tables. Jagan Mohan Reddy became the Chief Minister. In 2024, TDP joined NDA again jointly with **Pawan Kalyan**'s **Jan Sena Party** (JSP). NDA won an overwhelming majority and formed its Government on June 12, 2024. The results were as follows:



The electorate of **Thiruvananthapuram**, through a fair process, re-elected **Shashi Tharoor** (INC), albeit with a reduced majority. The Union minister **Rajeev Chandrasekhar** (BJP) lost the election and was dropped from the new Cabinet, which was sworn in on June 9, 2024. The **Communist Party of India** (CPI) candidate lost the election again.

Voter turnout remained robust, reflecting citizens' commitment to democracy.
