Held at CBS News' Broadcast Center Studio 45 in New York City, the debate showcased not only the candidates' positions but also a evolving format for political discourse in America.

1. It was the **only scheduled debate** between the VP candidates for the 2024 election.

2. For the first time since 1987, both major parties opted out of debates sponsored by the Commission on Presidential Debates (CPD).

The Contenders



Democrat: Tim Walz, Governor of Minnesota



****Republican****: JD Vance, the 40-year-old U.S. Senator from Ohio **Format and Moderation:** Moderated by Margaret Brennan and Norah O'Donnell of CBS News, the 90-minute debate introduced a notable change: both candidates' microphones remained on throughout, with CBS reserving the right to mute if necessary. This approach aimed to foster a more dynamic conversation while maintaining order.

Key Topics: The debate covered crucial issues facing the nation, with candidates focusing on:

- Defending their running mates' economic policies
- Abortion rights
- Immigration policy

By the Numbers: According to CNN's analysis:

- Tim Walz spoke for approximately 40 minutes and 42 seconds
- JD Vance had the floor for about 38 minutes and 59 seconds

Reception and Polls: The debate was largely considered a draw, with polls showing mixed results:

- A CNN poll showed a slight edge for Vance (51%) over Walz (49%)
- Other polls indicated similarly close margins or ties

Interestingly, major newspapers like The New York Times, The Wall Street Journal, and USA Today declared Vance the winner. However, some outlets favored Walz, highlighting the divided opinions among media commentators.

The Bigger Picture: This debate held particular significance due to the tight race between presidential candidates Kamala Harris and Donald Trump. With the possibility of this being the final debate of the campaign season, both vice presidential candidates had a crucial opportunity to sway undecided voters and make their case to the American public.
